## **ORDINANCE NO. 207**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TABOR, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO COLLECTION FEES

**BE IT ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Tabor, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED.** Subsection 1 of Section 106.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Tabor, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

1. Schedule of Fees. The fees for solid waste collection and disposal service, used or available, are:

A. For each residential premises and for each dwelling unit of a multiple-family dwelling - \$2.50 per month

B. For commercial, industrial and institutional premises – \$3.25 per month.

C. Each residential, commercial, industrial, and institutional building shall pay a recycling fee of \$0.75 per month. In the case of a property having multiple units at the same location each unit shall be a separate \$0.75 per month recycling fee to the City in addition to the monthly charges outlined in Paragraphs A and B of this subsection.

D. Water customers outside the City limits shall pay only the \$0.75 recycling fee per property.

**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
