ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TABOR, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO WATER SERVICE CHARGES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Tabor, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 92.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Tabor, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

92.02 RATES FOR SERVICE. Water service shall be furnished at the following monthly rates within the City: *(Code of Iowa, Sec. 384.84)*

Bulk water usage is billed at the rate of \$30.00 per 1,000 gallons. In no case shall the minimum bill be less than \$30.00.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
